## Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- negotiate with contractors and suppliers, and internal and external clients
- develop a strategy to achieve project outcomes and client requirements
- monitor, evaluate and report on progress of works
- resolve disagreements and disputes satisfactorily
- analyse project outcomes
- evaluate project achievements.

## Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- human resource management and policies
- capital works specifications and objectives
- project management systems
- project management tools and techniques
- cost schedule control systems
- enterprise procurement guidelines
- enterprise project management policies
- risk management techniques
- business and commercial issues
- basics of contract law
- physical resource management.

## Assessment Conditions

Competency is to be assessed in the workplace or simulated environment that accurately reflects performance in a real workplace setting.

Assessors must satisfy current standards for RTOs.
