Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- prepare for planting operations
- apply root treatments
- excavate planting holes
- inspect root ball condition
- install plants
- use tools and equipment for planting

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- principles and practices for planting trees and shrubs
 - basic plant structure and the physical and nutritional requirements of plants
 - botany and plant physiology as it applies to planting trees and shrubs
 - factors affecting the timing and method of tree or shrub planting
 - initial establishment needs of young plants
 - mulches and fertilisers
 - planting techniques relating to specific species
 - soil amelioration techniques
 - the effect of adverse outdoor climatic conditions
 - the impact of planting activities on the surrounding environment

Assessment Conditions

Assessors must satisfy current standards for RTOs.
