Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- follow biosecurity procedures
- make preparations to sex poultry
- identify hatchlings to be sexed
- sex poultry using feather or colour sexing methods
- handle birds appropriately
- · follow hygiene requirements
- follow administration requirements
- follow animal welfare requirements
- implement enterprise work health and safety policies

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- feather and colour sexing methods
- methods for identifying trays of hatchlings
- types and use, of machinery and equipment required
- relevant work health and safety requirements
- · methods and animal welfare considerations for handling and holding poultry
- relevant environmental and sustainability requirements, and procedures for disposal and management of wastes
- requirements and procedures for cleaning and maintaining work areas
- · relevant records that are required
- relevant biosecurity requirements

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Assessment Conditions

Competency is to be assessed in the workplace or workplace and simulated environment that accurately reflects performance in a real workplace setting.

Assessors must satisfy current standards for RTOs.
