Performance Evidence

The candidate must trim pig carcases prior to evisceration.

The candidate must:

- shave and remove ears, eyelids, snout and trotters in accordance with workplace and workplace health and safety requirements
- apply relevant regulatory requirements

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate a basic factual, technical and procedural knowledge of:

- the purpose of a pre-evisceration trim
- the quality implications of an incorrect trim
- the work instruction for the pre-evisceration trim
- relevant regulatory requirements
- possible sources of contamination and cross-contamination and methods used to avoid these situations

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must occur in the workplace under normal production conditions.

Competency must be demonstrated at chain speed.

As minimum, the following three forms of assessment must be used:

- quiz of underpinning knowledge
- workplace demonstration
- workplace referee or third-party report of performance over time

Assessors must satisfy the current standards for RTOs.
