Performance Evidence

The individual must trim the rumen to recover the mountain chain for further processing.

The individual must:

- trim mountain chain in accordance with specifications, workplace, workplace health and safety, Quality Assurance (QA), and hygiene and sanitation requirements
- recognise and trim defects
- apply relevant regulatory requirements.

Knowledge Evidence

The individual must demonstrate a basic factual, technical and procedural knowledge of:

- specifications for mountain chain
- impact of inadequately trimmed product being packed or processed
- relevant regulatory requirements.

Assessment Conditions

Competency must to be demonstrated at normal chain speed and an acceptable rate of recovery must be achieved.

Assessment must occur in the workplace under normal production conditions.

The following three forms of assessment must be used:

- demonstration in the workplace or simulated environment
- quiz of underpinning knowledge
- workplace referee or third-party report of performance over time.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
