Performance Evidence

The candidate must clean areas other than production areas in a meat processing plant.

The candidate must:

- locate and cite relevant safety data sheets
- use chemicals according to workplace and manufacturer's requirements
- clean according to schedules
- dispose of waste correctly
- · follow workplace health and safety policies and procedures
- apply relevant regulatory requirements
- use communication skills relevant to work instructions and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate a basic factual, technical and procedural knowledge of:

- monitoring of cleaned areas
- cleaning schedules for the range of areas
- waste disposal requirements
- importance of cleaning properly
- relevant regulatory requirements
- types of contamination

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a registered operating meat processing plant.

Competency must be demonstrated at normal rate of production.

As a minimum, the following three forms of assessment must be used:

- quiz of underpinning knowledge
- workplace demonstration

• workplace referee or third-party report of performance over time

Assessors must satisfy the current standards for RTOs.
