Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the candidate must demonstrate evidence of performance of the following on at least two occasions.

- using effective oral and written communication
- using reflection techniques to reflect on own and others' actions to inform analysis of incident response
- using analytical skills to assist in the examination of details relating to the incident and response

Knowledge Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the depth of knowledge demonstrated must be appropriate to the job context of the candidate.

- · organisation's policies and procedures related to incident response and reporting
- duty of care
- code of conduct
- language and style of communication appropriate for written reporting
- available resources that may assist post-incident analysis e.g. CCTV
- organisation's IT and information systems
- effective communication techniques

Assessment Conditions

Evidence for assessment must be gathered over time in a range of contexts to ensure the person can achieve the unit outcome and apply the competency in different situations or environments.

Valid assessment of this unit requires a workplace environment or one that closely resembles normal work practice and replicates the range of conditions likely to be encountered by an individual participating in incident briefings and analysis, including coping with irregularities and communicating with others.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
