## Performance Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

- produce observational drawings for at least three different projects.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- show well-developed technique using accurate perspective and depiction of light, shadow and space
- select media and tools to suit the needs of a particular drawing project
- use self-evaluation and feedback from others to identify and pursue further skill development.

## Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- techniques and considerations for observational drawings that include:
  - accurate perception of shape
  - approaches to line and edges
  - approaches to perspective
  - coordination of hand and eye
  - depiction of light and shade
  - representation of space
- work health and safety requirements relating to observational drawing
- how tools, media and techniques can be used to achieve particular effects in observational drawings.

## Assessment Conditions

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

This includes access to:

- information sources
- drawing materials and equipment
- interaction with applicable people.
