## Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- plan and supervise the installation of a lighting system for at least one production or event
- apply effective problem-solving techniques to the process of installing lighting systems
- work collaboratively.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided for each of the above points at least once.

## Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements the individual must:

- describe techniques for planning work when installing lighting systems into venues
- suggest ways to address issues and challenges that typically arise when installing lighting systems
- explain safety issues to be taken into account when installing lighting systems for productions and events
- describe industry trends and developments that impact on lighting operations
- explain the features of a range of lighting control systems
- provide examples of where to source a range of lighting equipment and accessories
- explain how a range of lighting equipment and accessories can be used to achieve different lighting effects.

## **Assessment Conditions**

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to venues where lighting systems need to be installed for productions.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
