Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- plan and implement ways to refine own skills, and monitor skill development progress
- perform improvisations using a range of advanced musical techniques
- give and respond to cues during solo improvisations.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- explain factors that contribute to excellence in improvisation
- describe typical ensemble customs, protocols and practices, in relation to improvisation
- describe issues that arise in the context of performing improvisations, and explain how they might be overcome
- outline work health and safety (WHS) principles relevant to performing improvisations.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to:

- relevant instruments and equipment
- performance opportunities as part of an ensemble
- appropriate venue with adequate space and acoustic qualities
- opportunities to perform for an audience.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
