#### **Performance Evidence**

- set up and test complex microphone plots and other audio input sources for at least two productions or events
- apply in-depth knowledge of microphone technology and product options to work activities
- manage a range of microphone and other audio inputs during technical run-throughs or rehearsals on at least two occasions
- correctly use terminology associated with input source management
- work collaboratively.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided for each of the above points at least once.

### **Knowledge Evidence**

To complete the unit requirements the individual must:

- explain the features of a range of different microphone and the contexts in which they are best used
- explain the acoustic consequences of signal phase problems and when to use phantom power
- provide examples of current trends in microphone development and the availability of products
- provide examples of issues and challenges that typically arise when managing audio input sources, along with solutions to address them

• provide example of issues to consider when preparing microphone plots and input signal failure plans.

#### **Assessment Conditions**

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to a range of microphones and audio equipment used to mix live audio.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
