# DEFINT003 Edit intelligence material for security purposes

## Modification History

Release 1. This is the first release of this unit of competency in the DEF Defence Training Package.

## Application

This unit specifies the skills and knowledge required to amend and arrange information into useful intelligence material, in accordance with specific security requirements.

It includes conducting source and method protection risk assessment of received information, and editing this data into intelligence material to achieve security criteria.

This unit applies to Defence intelligence operatives although it could apply to any personnel working in this field.

The skills and knowledge described in this unit must be applied within the legislative, regulatory and policy environment in which they are carried out. Organisational policies and procedures must be consulted and adhered to.

Persons undertaking this unit work independently or as part of a team, and perform complex tasks in unfamiliar contexts.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.
