#### **Performance Evidence**

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the candidate must demonstrate evidence of performance of the following on at least one occasion.

- interpreting orders
- leading an indirect fire weapon operating crew
- · conducting sight testing
- conducting non-technical inspections

## **Knowledge Evidence**

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the depth of knowledge demonstrated must be appropriate to the job context of the candidate.

- ammunition:
  - type colour hazard band labelling
  - marking
  - slot/batch numbers
  - packaging
  - nomenclature
- factors affecting local defence
- laws of armed conflict
- principles of camouflage
- safety precautions associated with the task

#### **Assessment Conditions**

Competency should be assessed in an actual workplace or in a simulated environment, with access to equipment and infrastructure appropriate to the outcome. Competency should be demonstrated over time to ensure the candidate is assessed across a variety of situations.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
