 assisted with the development, implementation and evaluation of monitoring and maintenance plans for at least 2 types of cleaning equipment including at least 1 type of steriliser

## **Knowledge Evidence**

The candidate must be able to demonstrate essential knowledge required to effectively complete tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit, manage tasks and manage contingencies in the context of the work role. This includes knowledge of:

- features, functions and tracking and monitoring systems of different reprocessing equipment:
  - ultrasonic washers
  - washer-disinfectors
  - · automated lubrication devices
  - leak testers
  - dryers
  - insulation testers
  - steam sterilisers
  - heat sealers

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- low temperature sterilisers
- administration and record keeping requirements:
  - testing and monitoring
  - validation requirements
  - maintenance and repair
  - recall systems
  - reporting as per AS/NZS 4187

#### **Assessment Conditions**

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions. The following conditions must be met for this unit:

- use of suitable facilities, equipment and resources, including:
  - cleaning and sterilisation equipment
  - test data for analysis
  - documentation for completion
  - equipment manuals and maintenance and repair records
- modelling of industry operating conditions, including presence of situations requiring problem solving

Assessors must satisfy the Standards for Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) 2015/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
