Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- correctly complete TWO jobs according to job specifications and enterprise procedures, ensuring addresses are affixed securely and in correct position, and any production problems are fixed with minimum downtime
- operate all safety devices on the machine.

If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- explain setup procedures to meet work health and safety and enterprise requirements
- explain the quality check process
- identify waste disposal procedures relevant to this task
- explain documentation required, where they are kept, and the information included.

Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances must be typical of those experienced in the converting, binding and finishing field of work and include access to a Cheshire labelling machine and special purpose tools, equipment and materials.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
