Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- set up and efficiently operate a machine to produce THREE different sewn products according to job specifications, listed performance criteria, and within production timeframes
- demonstrate all safety devices on the machine.

If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- explain work health and safety factors for setting up the machine
- establish effect of sewing in the wrong position
- identify largest/smallest size bag or sack that can be processed on the machine
- describe how to adapt the machines to facilitate smaller/larger stock.

Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances must be typical of those experienced in the converting, binding and finishing field of work and include access to relevant facilities, materials and access to a machine for sewn fastening.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
