Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- safely operate and set up an in-line cutter to complete TWO jobs to meet job specifications, including quality monitoring during the process and when packing the product.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- explain set-up procedures to meet work health and safety and enterprise requirements
- explain the quality check process
- identify and explain waste disposal procedures relevant to this task.

Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances must be typical of those experienced in the converting, binding and finishing field of work and include access to an in-line cutter and other special purpose tools, equipment and materials.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
