Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- correctly set up and operate a folder gluer machine according to job specifications, performance criteria, and within the production timeframe with minimum downtime or wastage.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- list common faults associated with folder gluer machines, the causes, and corrective measures
- describe correct procedures for set-up according to health and safety and workplace requirements
- explain types of adhesive used and why they are chosen.

Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances must be typical of those experienced in the converting, binding and finishing field of work and include access to a folder gluer machine and other special purpose tools, equipment and materials.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
