## Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- develop graphics based on a client brief using a high-end application
- demonstrate ability to find and use information relevant to the task from a variety of information sources.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

## Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- correctly identify image formats
- identify correct application to be used
- explain how graphics can be manipulated
- identify different colour models
- identify attributes of appearance
- list different effects that may be applied to an object
- explain use of filters
- list text and formatting features used in graphics
- outline key requirements when interpreting a brief.

## Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances must be typical of those experienced in the Pre-Press field of work and include access to:

- special purpose tools, equipment and material
- industry standard computer

- current software applications used to produce graphics.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
