Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- effectively manage a shift or sections production
- create a portfolio of documents showing how:
 - machine operations, staff and production processes are organised
 - quality standards and safe work practices are checked for compliance with procedures and legislative requirements
 - production is monitored for compliance
 - production improvement are identified, recorded, reported and implemented.
(Suitable documents for the portfolio include production summaries, quality-related documentation and testimonials from superiors and workers being supervised.)

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

Requirements for efficient production standards

- describe the work health and safety requirements for production control
- explain how the production process information is obtained
- outline quality standards to check to ensure enterprise procedures are met
- outline quality standards to check to ensure environmental protection requirements are met
- identify monitoring systems available to aid production management

Maintaining production efficiency

- identify problems that could cause non-compliance of production efficiency and how they can occur

- describe what information is necessary to efficiently plan, schedule and reschedule production

Improving production efficiency

- identify who has authority to implement production changes
- describe the information that needs to be communicated to implement changes to production control.

Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances must be typical of those experienced in the Support field of work and include access special purpose tools, equipment and materials.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
