Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

- led the development and deployment of sustainability strategy (including scope, timeline, key performance indicators and budget) for at least 1 organisation or part of an organisation
- led at least 1 periodic review of sustainability strategy.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- process and changes which occur at each step in selected value chain
- principles of sustainability
- causes of adverse social, economic and ecological impacts and methods of controlling or reducing them
- principles of strategy deployment and hoshin kanri
- development of vision, mission and strategy
- root cause analysis
- hierarchy of hazard control and its application to sustainability hazards
- sustainability hierarchy
- project management principles and the management of multiple related projects
- sustainability legislation, regulation and protocols, government incentives and initiatives
- risk analysis and its application to sustainability risks.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions, contingencies, facilities, equipment and resources.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
