### Application

This unit describes the skills required to inspect and report on river flow performance including flood plains and river environment. This includes monitoring river conditions, water quality, maintaining integrity of the bank, regulating and monitoring flows.

This unit applies to field staff with the responsibility of inspecting rivers.

The skills and knowledge described in this unit must be applied within the legislative, regulatory and policy environment in which they are carried out. Organisational policies and procedures must be consulted and adhered to.

Those undertaking this unit would work under supervision, performing routine tasks, in familiar contexts.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to unit at the time of publication.
