Performance Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the candidate must demonstrate evidence of performance of the following on at least one occasion.

- interpreting and reviewing hydraulic, architectural and site plans
- identifying and evaluating trade waste processes
- interpreting and evaluating sample analysis data
- developing monitoring plans
- managing stakeholders
- exercising judgement when revising work
- managing change in customer demands

Knowledge Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the depth of knowledge demonstrated must be appropriate to the job context of the candidate.

- relevant legislation
- relevant enterprise policies and procedures for connection management, customer connections and metering guides and supplier instructions
- water quality parameters of significance to the wastewater system
- basic hydraulics
- property spatial information
- property creation processes
- · basic knowledge of wastewater collection, treatment and disposal systems
- investigation procedures
- customer expectations and requirements
- WHS

Assessment Conditions
