Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and demonstrated the ability to:

- shift materials safely by hand at least once to meet work order requirements.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- principles of safe manual handling
- safe handling procedures and work health and safety regulations for the specific materials being shifted
- types and applications of tools and equipment used for moving polymer materials

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
