- types and features of advanced or complex dies, including:
 - · unscrewing systems
 - external power and control sources
 - sliding blocks or cores
 - safety interlocks
- special features of tooling for injection moulding production of thin-wall takeaway containers
- special features of hot-runner multi-cavity tooling
- special features of tooling for thermoset silicone injection moulding
- special features of tooling for large products such as bread crates
- typical process and product problems, including early warning signs, possible causes and corrective actions.

Assessment Conditions


Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies
