## Performance Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the candidate must demonstrate evidence of performance of the following on at least one occasion.

- applying change management to implement new or improved practice and processes
- assessing alternative approaches
- following procedures relating to public sector legislation, including WHS and environment, in the context of court practice and process
- performing statistical analyses
- evaluating policies and procedures using research and analysis
- consulting with a diverse range of people, particularly the judiciary, legal profession and litigants

## Knowledge Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the depth of knowledge demonstrated must be appropriate to the job context of the candidate.

- courts administration structure
- legislation conferring jurisdiction on the courts
- practice, processes and systems used in courts
- principles of analysis
- principles of change management
- principles of judicial independence
- structure, roles and functions of courts

## Assessment Conditions

Assessment of this unit requires a workplace environment or one that closely resembles normal work practice and replicates the diverse conditions likely to be encountered when managing practice and process.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
