Erect concrete crash barriers	<p>2.1 Set out position of concrete crash barriers according to job drawings and specifications</p> <p>2.2 Erect and/or install barriers in the correct location</p> <p>2.3 Join barriers according to manufacturer's specifications</p> <p>2.4 Seal and finish barriers against weather</p>
3. Clean up	<p>3.1 Clear work area and dispose of or recycle materials</p> <p>3.2 Store or stack unused materials</p> <p>3.3 Clean, check, maintain and store plant, tools and equipment</p>
