prepare work area	<p>plans and specifications and location for placement is free of debris and waste</p> <p>2.2 Maintain safe working area around pour location using barriers and signage</p> <p>2.3 Locate plant, tools and equipment to suit planned placement</p> <p>2.4 Undertake pre-pour inspections before concrete arrives on site</p>
3. Place concrete and compact	<p>3.1 Place concrete in horizontal layers into location to levels indicated by markers, level pegs or lines</p> <p>3.2 Minimise height of vertical drop of concrete to avoid segregation of concrete materials</p> <p>3.3 Consolidate poured concrete during process using approved compaction or vibration method</p> <p>3.4 Check finished levels against datum using levelling device</p>
4. Screed/level concrete	<p>4.1 Screed concrete to correct levels and grades using straight edged tool/formwork mounted screed</p>
5. Clean up	<p>5.1 Clear work area and dispose, reuse or recycle materials</p> <p>5.2 Clean, check, maintain and store plant, tools and equipment</p>
