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	<p>1.7 Check records, identify outstanding maintenance inspections and record identified defects</p> <p>1.8 Use approved dust suppression and extraction methods</p>

Monitor and manage operations	<p>2.1 Monitor and manage operations using appropriate indicators</p> <p>2.2 Manage faults</p> <p>2.3 Communicate with equipment operators and personnel using approved communication methods</p> <p>2.4 Complete all required documentation clearly, concisely and on time</p> <p>2.5 Pass on end-of-shift information to oncoming shift</p>
3. Conduct housekeeping activities	<p>3.1 Clean equipment</p> <p>3.2 Clean and store auxiliary service equipment</p>
