Implement grazing strategies during establishment	3.1 Use livestock to conduct stubble and fallow weed control as part of an integrated pest management program where appropriate. 3.2 Use livestock to conduct stubble, ground cover, competition or weed control during establishment. 3.3 Implement appropriate controlled grazing of crops and pastures during pasture and crop establishment 3.4 Implement appropriate grazing management according to sustainable land management practices
