Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- build or purchase a suitable pollen trap
- assess suitability of colonies for pollen collection
- correctly wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE)
- collect and process pollen
- manage the hive
- maintain records
- handle bees
- clean and sanitise equipment.

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- principles and practices of trapping and storing pollen
- bee colony pollen requirements
- bee handling techniques
- floral sources of pollen production
- quality assurance requirements designed for the honey industry
- requirements for commercial processing.

Assessment Conditions

Assessors must satisfy current standards for RTOs.
