## Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- gather and analyse data relating to enterprise performance
- review operational structures to determine effectiveness
- identify available resources to assess capacity
- develop realistic performance indicators
- review enterprise operations against performance indicators
- plan to improve business performance by addressing results of review
- monitor and manage resources
- assess sustainability of resource use.

## Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- rates of return for products and services
- financial analysis techniques
- structure and operation of small businesses and the relevant State and Territory work health and safety
- legislative requirements
- environmental conditions, positive environmental practices and negative impact minimisation measures
- human resource requirements for the enterprise
- transport requirements for the enterprise
- enterprise and property improvement requirements
- market performance in commodities
- statutory marketing requirements.

## **Assessment Conditions**

Competency is to be assessed in the workplace or simulated environment that accurately reflects performance in a real workplace setting.

Assessors must satisfy current standards for RTOs.
