Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- develop evaluation approach and criteria
- develop review panel and review processes
- evaluate submissions against criteria
- communicate panel decisions to project applicants, including feedback on the reasons for decisions
- prepare reports to agency, project or program requirements

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- facilitation and mediation techniques
- legislation and regulations appropriate to projects being submitted
- basic budgeting skills
- reporting and publishing requirements
- data collection and analysis techniques

Assessment Conditions

Assessors must satisfy current standards for RTOs.
