Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- interpret site plans and specifications
- set out and prepare a site for concrete
- measure and construct profiles
- establish levels using levelling equipment
- place reinforcement
- pour, consolidate and finish concrete

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- the principles and practices of constructing concrete landscape features
- industry standards in relation to reinforcing and consolidating concrete
- MPA testing theory and what affects MPA specifications in a concrete mix
- sub-base and sub-grade materials and preparation
- the comparative environmental implications associated with soil removal and the placement of concrete
