This unit of competency describes the skills and knowledge required to prepare for, carry out and shut down front-end loader operations in an agricultural environment.

Vehicle must be operated according to relevant state/territory licensing authority vehicle licence requirements and regulations.

No occupational licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.

Operate front-end loader	2.1 Carry out pre-start, and start up procedures according to health and safety in the workplace guidelines 2.2 Drive and operate front-end loader, and modify operating technique to meet changing work conditions 2.3 Select loading technique and modify where required to meet changing work conditions 2.4 Use attachments according to manufacturer instructions and site requirements 2.5 Continually monitor hazards and risks, and ensure safety of self, other personnel, plant and equipment 2.6 Identify environmental and biosecurity implications associated with front-end loader operation and minimise impact 2.7 Complete work task according to the agreed plan and within the operating capacity of the equipment and operator
3. Complete front-end loader operation	3.1 Park front-end loader and conduct shut down procedures 3.2 Perform routine operational servicing and minor maintenance according to front-end loader operation and maintenance manual 3.3 Identify and report malfunctions, faults, irregular performance or damage to supervisor 3.4 Clean, secure and store front-end loader 3.5 Remove and store keys in the required location 3.6 Maintain front-end loader use records in required format

Pre-operational checks must include:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>maintenance interval schedule daily check</li> <li>machine damage and serviceability</li> <li>checking for missing parts</li> <li>fluid leaks and levels</li> <li>fuel level</li> <li>brakes and clutch operation</li> <li>condition of tyres or tracks</li> <li>machine controls.</li> </ul>
Attachments must include at least one of the following:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>bale fork</li> <li>bucket</li> <li>bull blades</li> <li>log fork</li> <li>pallet fork</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• S Houle rock bucket</li> <li>• silage fork.</li> </ul>
Biosecurity implications must include:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• control of cross-site contamination.</li> </ul>
