Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- prepare for plant collecting
- note the location, characteristics and occurrence of specimens at the point of collection
- clean, preserve, mount and label specimens
- use a plant key to identify plants against the botanical description of the species

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- principles and practices of plant classification
 - herbarium collection techniques and ethics
 - physical and biological habitat types including vegetation associations and communities where appropriate
 - plant anatomy, physiology, morphology, taxonomy and nomenclature

Assessment Conditions

Assessors must satisfy current standards for RTOs.
