Performance Evidence

An individual demonstrating competency must satisfy all of the elements and performance criteria in this unit.

There must be evidence that the individual has supported gardening work on at least two occasions, and has:

- prepared tools and equipment
- applied safe work practices in gardening work, including fitted and used personal protective equipment (PPE)
- handled materials and equipment
- undertaken gardening work as directed
- cleaned up on completion of gardening work
- reported work outcomes and faulty, worn or damage of tools.

Knowledge Evidence

An individual must be able to demonstrate the knowledge required to perform the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit. This includes knowledge of:

- principles and practices of gardening work, including:
 - garden tools and equipment
 - maintenance practices for planted areas
 - planting techniques
- safe work practices used in gardening work.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment of the skills in this unit of competency must take place under the following conditions:

- physical conditions:
 - a workplace setting or an environment that accurately represents workplace conditions

- resources, equipment and materials:
 - work instructions and workplace procedures applicable to supporting gardening work
 - gardening materials, tools and equipment
 - PPE applicable to supporting gardening work
- relationships:
 - supervisor, staff and customers
- timeframes:
 - according to job requirements.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
