Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- set out conservation earthworks
- identify hazards and ensure the safety of self, field operators and any other person on site
- interpret plans and specifications
- relate plan to site
- measure out site dimensions precisely and peg project
- protect site

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- different types of survey equipment
- civil engineering and survey techniques applicable to conservation earthworks
- erosion control and design principles
- principles of native topsoil conservation and protection
- interpretation of plans and general and technical specification

Assessment Conditions

Assessors must satisfy current standards for RTOs.
