Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- prepare for seed identification
- recognise or identify seed to genus and, where possible, species level
- contribute to enterprise seed reference collection

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- binomial nomenclature
- concepts of seed identification
- enterprise and/or legal traceability requirements
- enterprise standard operating procedures (SOPs)
- relevant work health, safety and environment requirements
- seed identification techniques
- the role of the International Seed Testing Association (ISTA) and the ISTA Rules for Seed Testing

Assessment Conditions

Assessors must satisfy current standards for RTOs.
