Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- · investigate the circumstances and logistics for the emergency
- carry out preparation and move to the rescue site
- · assess the situation and establish communication with additional or specialist help
- · carry out the required rescue or response to emergency
- implement post incident responses
- use industry standard terminology
- apply workplace health and safety in the context of own work.

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- local environmental conditions
- search and rescue methods
- · operation and characteristics of rescue equipment, tools and vehicles
- environmental, public health and safety issues
- types of hazards and how they should be handled
- enterprise procedures, legislative and work health and safety requirements
- first aid, life preservation.

Assessment Conditions

Assessors must satisfy current standards for RTOs.
