Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- identify and reporting issues that impact on product quality
- follow quality assurance practices
- implement standard operating procedures
- contribute to reviews of work output against quality standards
- complete records
- determine critical control points for work area
- use industry standard terminology.

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- industry quality assurance requirements
- work processes in own field of work
- Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point (HACCP) approach to quality assurance
- workplace procedures, policies, guidelines and standard operating procedures for own area of work.

Assessment Conditions

Assessors must satisfy current standards for RTOs.
