Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

- identify a wide range of vegetation common to the region
- · recognise plant health problems and defects
- perform hazard identification and risk control procedures
- · conduct soil field tests
- estimate dimensions and gradients
- report findings to the client or supervisor
- use industry standard terminology.

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- plan and map interpretation
- soil pH, texture, structure and type
- plant identification and plant physiology
- measuring and estimating methods
- current land use and environmental threats to site hazards associated with undertaking site inspections
- protocols of accessing and visiting a site
- relevant legislative and regulatory requirements including environmental protection legislation
- local government regulations relating to the proximity of trees to buildings, services and roads
- local tree protection and preservation regulations
- relevant Codes of Practice.
