Performance Evidence

An individual demonstrating competency must satisfy all of the elements and performance criteria in this unit.

There must be evidence that the individual has collected samples for a rural production or horticulture monitoring program on at least one occasion and has:

- planned for collection of samples and moved equipment to the site
- used and operated sampling tools and equipment relevant to the sampling activity
- applied workplace health and safety requirements, including fitted and used personal protective equipment (PPE)
- followed sampling plan
- preserved samples for a given site
- prepared samples for external analysis
- packaged samples for transport to laboratory
- made observations and distinguished atypical circumstances
- recorded sampling results and observations on data sheets.

Knowledge Evidence

An individual must be able to demonstrate the knowledge required to perform the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit. This includes knowledge of:

- field procedures for sampling and preservation
- collecting equipment and methods
- preservation equipment and processes
- workplace requirements applicable to health and safety in the workplace for collecting samples for rural production or horticulture monitoring programs
- sample recording and reporting procedures.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment of the skills in this unit of competency must take place under the following conditions:

- physical conditions:
 - a workplace setting or an environment that accurately represents workplace conditions
- resources, equipment and materials:
 - sample collection, tools and equipment
 - PPE applicable to collecting samples for rural production or horticulture monitoring programs
- specifications:
 - workplace health and safety legislation, regulations, codes of practice and workplace procedures relevant to collecting samples for rural production or horticulture monitoring programs
- relationships:
 - supervisor.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
