Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- identify hazards and critical control points in the production of quality product
- assist in planning of quality assurance procedures
- provide induction and in-service staff training
- implement quality assurance procedures
- use industry standard terminology.

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- market requirements for product
- definition of quality
- quality specifications for product
- enterprise and industry quality assurance systems
- Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points (HACCP) techniques
- strategies for control of hazards to quality
- work place training strategies
- delegation and empowerment
- contingency management.

Assessment Conditions

Assessors must satisfy current standards for RTOs
