Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- identify client or organisation expectations
- determine the scope of items for audit
- specify parameters of audit requirements
- define the audit process
- identify compliance and noncompliance items
- implement an audit
- manage the implementation of audits
- plan for and act on contingencies
- evaluate audit findings
- organise scheduling and meetings
- use industry standard terminology.

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- audit methodology and techniques
- product or service
- quality principles and techniques
- interview techniques
- workplace documentation and policies
- logistics of operations of organisation
- legal issues and terminology relating to quality auditing
- award and enterprise agreements and relevant industrial instruments
- relevant legislation and regulations from all levels of government
- relevant codes of practice, regulations and Standards.

Assessment Conditions

Assessors must satisfy current standards for RTOs.
