Performance Evidence

The candidate must remove, dispose of and record stock identification tags.

The candidate must:

- follow work instructions for the removal of tags
- record tags accurately
- apply relevant workplace health and safety requirements
- use communication skills as appropriate to the task

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate a basic factual, technical and procedural knowledge of:

- the function and importance of tags
- the importance of maintaining correlation between carcass and tags
- the need for correct disposal of tags
- the regulations with regard to tags
- the relationship between tags and residue testing

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in an operating abattoir.

Competency must be demonstrated at chain speed.

As a minimum, the following three forms of assessment must be used:

- quiz of underpinning knowledge
- workplace demonstration
- workplace referee or third-party report of performance over time

Assessors must satisfy the current standards for RTOs.
