# Assessment Requirements for AMPA2150 Skin condemned carcase

## Performance Evidence

The candidate must remove the skin or hide of a condemned carcase.

The candidate must:

- hoist and skin carcase in accordance with workplace health and safety requirements

## Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate a basic factual, technical and procedural knowledge of:

- workplace health and safety requirements related to skinning a condemned carcase
- risks to hide quality through inaccurate skinning cuts

## Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in an operating processing plant.

Competency must be demonstrated at the speed required in an operating processing plant.

As a minimum, the following three forms of assessment must be used:

- quiz of underpinning knowledge
- workplace demonstration
- workplace referee or third-party report of performance over time

Assessors must satisfy the current standards for RTOs.
