Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to operate a field harvesting vehicle safely and hygienically.

This unit applies to individuals who operate vehicles for wild game harvesting for commercial purposes. Operators have responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the field harvesting vehicle, the loading and unloading of carcasses and the safe handling of cleaning chemicals and equipment.

All work must be carried out to comply with workplace procedures, according to state/territory health and safety, food and meat safety regulations, animal welfare regulations, legislation and standards that apply to the workplace.

Legislative and regulatory requirements apply to wild game harvesting and are enforced through state/territory jurisdictions. Users must check with the relevant regulatory authority before delivery.

Mandatory workplace requirements apply to the assessment of this unit.

Clean field harvester vehicle and equipment	4.1 Clean vehicle to meet regulatory requirements 4.2 Use cleaning chemicals that meet regulatory requirements according to manufacturer instructions 4.3 Clean kit and hanging pins according to the management plan 4.4 Store kit and hanging pins to avoid contamination 4.5 Identify and organise any vehicle or equipment maintenance requirements 4.6 Complete records in line with regulatory and workplace requirements
