# Assessment Requirements for AUMATK004 Use and maintain measuring equipment

#### **Performance Evidence**

Before competency can be determined, individuals must have competently used measuring equipment on a minimum of three occasions.

Individuals must demonstrate they can:

- observe workplace procedures relating to the use and maintenance of measuring equipment
- select measuring equipment
- check the currency of calibration of the measuring equipment
- use a range of relevant measuring equipment
- · carry out maintenance of measuring equipment
- store measuring equipment.

## **Knowledge Evidence**

Individuals must be able to demonstrate knowledge of:

- workplace procedures and work health and safety requirements relating to the use and maintenance of measuring equipment
- types of measuring equipment
- · procedures for calibrating measuring equipment
- handling and storage of measuring equipment
- procedures for recording results and reporting equipment faults.

#### **Assessment Conditions**

Assessors must satisfy SNR/AQTF assessor requirements.

Competency is to be assessed in the workplace or a simulated environment that accurately reflects performance in a real workplace setting.

Where assessment of competency includes third-party evidence, individuals must provide evidence that links them to using and maintaining measuring equipment, e.g. work orders.

Assessors must verify performance evidence through questioning on skills and knowledge to ensure correct interpretation and application.

The following resources must be made available:

- automotive manufacturing workplace or simulated workplace
- measuring equipment required in the production process
- · measuring equipment operating procedures
- workplace procedures relating to the use and maintenance of measuring equipment
- procedures for calibrating measuring equipment.
