Release 1. This is the first release of this unit of competency in the AVI Aviation Training Package.

## **Application**

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to conduct housekeeping activities.

It includes identifying required housekeeping requirements, procedures and resources for different areas of the workplace, monitoring and maintaining cleanliness and tidiness in the workplace, and completing assigned housekeeping tasks.

This unit addresses aviation technical skill requirements (physical, mental and task-management abilities) related to safety management duties of ground operations personnel, and contributes to safe and effective performance in complex aviation operational environments.

Operations are conducted as part of recreational, commercial and military aircraft activities across a variety of operational contexts within the Australian aviation industry.

Work is performed independently or under limited supervision as a single operator or within a team environment.

No licensing, legislative, regulatory or certification requirements are applicable to this unit at time of publication

## **Range of Conditions**

Range is restricted to essential operating conditions and any other variables essential to the work environment.

Hazards in the work area will include exposure to one or more of the following:

- chemicals
- dangerous or hazardous substances
- movements of equipment, goods and materials

Personal protective equipment must include one or more of the following items:

- gloves
- safety headwear and footwear
- safety glasses
- two-way radios
- · high visibility clothing

Housekeeping duties must include one or more of the following:

- cleaning
- maintenance
- repacking
- returning goods or equipment to storage
- · waste removal
